Marriott Vacations Worldwide is committed to the development of our future leaders, and as a result, has established the **Management Development Program (MDP)** which is an intensive immersion program offering participant work experience throughout a resort. While working with site leadership, participants will also have the opportunity to develop and demonstrate their leadership, management and hospitality skills.

The program cultivates knowledge, skills and abilities through on the job experience, as well as exposure to business leaders. Each participant will be given the opportunity to specialize in one or more of the following departments as part of their Core Program: Front Office, Housekeeping, Food & Beverage, or Facilities Management. In addition to the specialization, complimentary department rotations are included as well.

The MDP is designed to last 6-12 months depending upon the participant's previous experience and the needs of the property. Please note that most programs encompass full 12 months. The site leaders and regional HR leaders will work with successful participants to place them in management positions upon completion of the MDP.

The MDP offers a combination of learning activities, task-based assignments, practical work experience, and the ability to practice and develop leadership skills. In addition, a dedicated mentor/sponsor is assigned to each participant in order to assist them with navigating through the program.

MDP Overview:

- **Self-Paced Program** designed for individual learning styles
- **Hands-On Work Experience** interacting with Owners, guests and associates while building operational expertise
- **Leadership Development Courses and Training** specific to MVW culture and our core business
- **Cross-Training Opportunities** in other departments at a resort

MDP participants will earn a salary as non-exempt managers in addition to a starting bonus and will be eligible to participate in our benefits package including medical, dental, vision, 401K, Short/Long term disability, Life Insurance, and the Marriott hotel discounts.
